

# Quickfixes

## Relaunch KDE Plasma after freeze

Sometimes after some weeks of uptime when I entered my office in the morning, I discovered a frozen Plasma. To fix this, enter the system via SSH and then execute this command:

```
sudo service sddm stop
```

And without re-login:

```
kquitapp5 plasmashell && kstart5 plasmashell
```

## Setlocale failed Debian/Ubuntu

If you got any error of the following when running apt or anything else:

```
locale: Cannot set LC_ALL to default locale: No such file or directory
```

```
perl: warning: Falling back to the standard locale ("C")
```

```
perl: warning: Setting locale failed.
```

Just run the following command and select the correct locale:

```
sudo dpkg-reconfigure locales
```

Or use:

```
sudo localectl set-locale en_US.UTF-8
```
