

# Run remote-signed PowerShell Scripts

Windows blocks the execution of remote signed PowerShell scripts by default. If your execution policy still has this setting, you might see this error message:

```
C:\Users\test-user\Downloads\Install.ps1 is not digitally signed. You cannot run this script on the current system. For more information about running scripts and setting execution policy, see about_Execution_Policies at https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=135170. At line:1 char:1 + .\Install.ps1 + ~~~~~ + CategoryInfo          : SecurityError: (:) [], PSSecurityException + FullyQualifiedErrorId : UnauthorizedAccess
```

Just run the following command as Administrator within a PowerShell console:

```
set-executionpolicy remotesigned
```
